Chairman's Report

- 1. Cllr Iles visited the Clerk and advised him of the death of Rosemary his wife. The funeral was held on the 31st of March and was attended by the Clerk the Chair and Cllr Jones.
- 2. The Clerk has agreed with Sainsbury's a donation of £380 towards planter pots outside their store. The Amenities committee agreed that the Clerk should purchase six planters for the Bonc & Wylfa Hill and with Sainsbury's contribution amounts to ten pots.
- 3. The seat and planter to be located at New Brighton has been received and is stored at the Argoed Club. The plinth has been built on site and once plants are received the planter will be put in place and Flintshire will secure the seat to the plinth.
- 4. The new computer crashed approximately a week ago and was sent back to PC World under guarantee. The Clerk spoke to them to day and was advised a Fujitsu engineer is due to correct it tomorrow.
- 5. Redbud Ltd has visited the memorial garden and has tidied up the area and will continue to maintain the site. The border outside the library will also get attention in the next few weeks.
- 6. LDP committee held a meeting at the centre on the 12th of March where software called Survey Monkey was reviewed and provided members with ideas on progressing a survey in the Argoed area.
- 7. At the Amenities Meeting the Clerk was requested to write to the residents of Rockliffe asking them to return the plinth to its rightful place within seven days. The residents have complied with the request.
- 8. The Biodiversity officer visited the Amenities Committee and provided useful information to members .Members confirmed that the officer had provided some useful information for the development of the quarry.
- 9. The Clerk and The Chair attended a training event titled "Playing Out In Flintshire" which provided an interesting concept of how to set up play areas to help with the development of children. One point that came across was that often that health and safety was often overplayed when setting up a play area, and natural play equipment exists such as trees etc tend to be of more benefit than the strictly planned playgrounds as it allows children to use imagination. The members were told that slides of used in the training event would forwarded to the Clerk and he will provide copies of relevant pages to the Amenities Committee.

Minutes of Amenities Committee held on Wednesday at 6.00 pm 19th March 2014at the Community Centre Mercia Square, Mynydd Isa.

Recording of Minutes: Committee members were advised that the minutes were not being recorded.

Minutes for February 19th were accepted by Committee

The Biodiversity Officer for Flintshire joined the committee and discussions on what could be done at the quarry were informative. Items discussed were as follows:

Limestone paths were acceptable including crush and run and they would be suitable for disabled people to travel along but should choose small grained limestone. The Officer would email the Clerk on the type.

Ponds are a wonderful exploration area for children and the Council should not be too weary of the health and safety aspects but you still have to be careful.

Bird Tabled: should be introduced to draw in more wildlife. **Bug Hotels** are very good item to add to encourage Children to investigate bugs etc.

A hedgehog would be useful you might be able to get local hedgehog hospital to home one in the quarry.

The Meadow should be retained.

Wildlife gardening Pack. The officer suggested getting a wildlife pack. The Clerk informed the Committee that he has already applied for one.

Poppies would look nice along the bank and if you plant bulbs you should be native.

Funding is available from Tidy Town, Cadwyn Clwyd, Woodland Trust and the British Legion.

After discussions the Officer left the Committee **Bench/Two tier Planter:** The Clerk informed the committee that the Bench should be received within a week

Christmas tree the member for New Brighton requested a permanent tree in New Brighton.

Recommendation: Further information is required on the type of tree and its cost

Bryn Y Baal Quarry:

The Chair of the committee had called around to the residents of the Quarry leaving photographs of the boundary for their consideration.

Recommendation: The Clerk to draft letter to the residents and ask them to return the plinth within 7days.

Y Bonc it was decided to delay this item until the next meeting when Cllr McGuill could be present

Play Equipment: The requirements for the two parks at Argoed and Heol Fammau will be needed when the match Funding has been approved.

Vale Park it was agreed that a tonne of earth should delivered when possible. Cllr Norwood would check if it's necessary for a retainer to be built.
