#### 4. Police Report South Flintshire Local Policing Team

**Incident update -** (from 27/04/2018 to 02/06/2018)

#### Anti-Social Behaviour Issues/Trends:

<u>04/05/2018</u> – Group of youths have knocked barriers down which were being used for gas works on Park Avenue. The males also started to go on to individuals' driveways. Officers attended but negative sightings of the youths. Gas works are now gone.

23/05/2018 – A report of a group of youths coming out of abandoned property on Rose Lane. Officers attended and located youths. Words of advice were given to youths to stay away from the property. This will be monitored and patrols will be carried out.

<u>25/05/2018</u> - Group of youths congregating on the footpath of Erw Goed and playing loud music. Youths had left when informant reported the incident. Incident logged and Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) made aware for patrols to be carried out in the area.

28/05/2018 – Group of youths being abusive and causing a nuisance in the Watts Dyke park. Officers attended but negative sightings of youths.

<u>29/05/2018</u> – Three males attempting to light a fire on Chambers Lane. Officers attended but negative sightings of males.

#### Crime Issues / Trends

There has been a report of parking issues on Chamber Lane outside the junior school. Local PCSO made aware in order to carry out patrols. Informant given words of advice to inform the council.

A number of reports of youths causing a nuisance on Park Avenue. Cones/ barriers keep getting moved around and the workmen's wheelbarrow/ other equipment has been taken.

Officers carried out area search but negative sightings of youths. Wheelbarrow was returned to the site.

There has been a report that a few items have been stolen from a garage that was left unlocked overnight in the Uwch-y-Nant area. CCTV at the property and males can be seen entering the garage. However, the quality of the CCTV is poor and the males cannot be identified. House to house carried out and CSI attended. On-going investigation. A report of a vehicle parked on a bend on Heol Fammau. Officer attended and carried out checks on vehicle. Vehicle had no tax and no insurance and was therefore, recovered
