3. Quarry

The outstanding issues that need to be actioned in the Quarry are a site inspection, the brambles which are overgrowing into neighbouring properties, the tree in the cliff-face which is re-growing, the gate needs fixing and a sign put on it, bug boxes to be installed.

The work done to the path is to be checked and consideration given to the suggestion that either a pump track or skate park could be installed there.

5. Biodiversity

Clerk advised that the list attached to the agenda contained suggestions from the template document from Welsh Government.

Resolved: That the Council actions the following:

- Organise an Eco Quiz
- Arrange awareness raising and training sessions for members and staff.
- Encourage the community to volunteer more.

- Review the grant policy to encourage more biodiversity projects.
- Share information on our website and social media, share pictures of wildlife in our community and details of how they've been attracted to the area.
- Create more wildlife area in public spaces, to provide nesting and hibernating areas, to encourage a range of species.
- Install bug boxes in the Quarry.
- Review procurement with Viking to check that office supplies are sustainably sourced.
- Create a composting area in the Quarry.
- Include requirement for environmentally friendly tools.
- Take advice from the Local Environmental Record Centres on local sites and species of interest.
- Incorporate an award to recognise the achievements of either a resident or local organisation who is championing environmental issues.
- Continue to work in partnership with the Local Wildlife Trust to provide extra volunteers to improve local wildlife in the area.

6. Christmas Decorations

Clerk advised that there are Christmas decorations which match our existing stock currently on sale with Festive Lights. It was noted that residents from New Brighton and Bryn-y-Baal had written to ask for lights to be installed in their areas.

Resolved: That 10 new lights be bought, 3 to be installed in New Brighton, 3 to be installed in Bryn-y-Baal, 2 to be installed near Wylfa Hill as you come into Mynydd Isa and 2 to be installed by where you enter into Mynydd Isa from Buckley.
